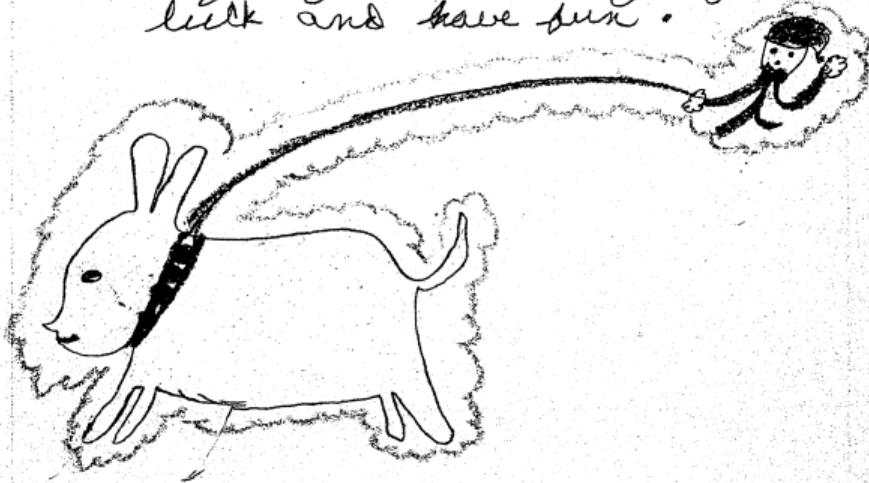

luck and have fun.



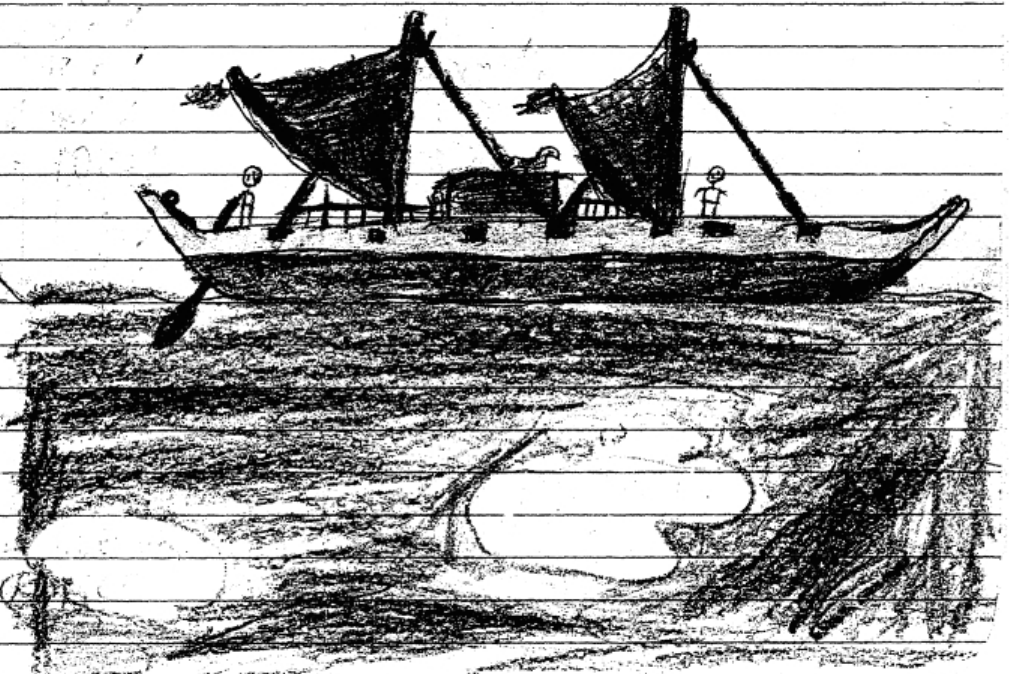
