

You all know Leinani Faria and Waldorf Wilson, but how much do you know about their sporting backgrounds? Let me share with you the information I've received from Chris Faria and Dorothy Wilson.

Leinani was the Womens Water Skiing Slalom Winner in the Hawaiian Islands Water Ski Club in 1967 as well as the President to the Hawaiian Islands Water Ski Club from 1965 to 1969.

She was the Secretary and Head Recorder to the Hawaiian Power Boat Association from 1962 to 1968. In addition to that she was a Registered Official with them from 1965 to 1969.

Leinani joined the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association as Head Race Recorder in 1969. A position she held until 1977. During those years she served as Secretary from 1971 to 1973, Executive Secretary from 1974 to 1977, Race Rules Committee 1974 to 1977, Treasurer 1975 to 1977 and Canoe Race Committee from 1976 to 1977. During that time she was also the Editor to the HCRA Race Rules Book from 1973 to 1977. In 1978 the top achievement was achieved, she was elected President to the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association. (The First Female to hold this office).

In 1977 Leinani served as the Secretary to the Molokai-Oahu Race Committee for Aloha Week.

As a result of all her help with Hawaiian Canoe Racing, Leinani received the 1978 Scotty Schuman Award from the Honolulu Quarterback Club for her outstanding contributions, and again she was the First Female to receive this honor.

Leinani has received letters and resolutions from Hawaii's Congress of the United States, Inouye, Akaka, Matsunaga, Governor Ariyoshi, Mayor Fasi, the City Council and both houses of the legislature, as to have been the first woman ever to be singled out in this area of sports, Canoe Racing in modern Hawaii. She received this March 24, 1978.

Waldorf has also had quite a sporting background. He was a member of Hui Nalu Canoe Club from 1938 to 1940. While with them he paddled #3 in the Senior 4 and #5 in the Senior 6.

He was a member of Scotty Schuman's "Team Town" Football Team in 1939 as well as a member of Scotty Schuman's "Healani" Football Team from 1940 to 1942.

Waldorf has been a member of Mid Pacific Country Club from 1947 to the present. (By the way his current Golf Handicap is 7 and his best Handicap ever held was 4). While with Mid Pacific he has held several offices such as Vice President in 1972 and President in 1973. He has been a Director for 15 years. He has chaired all of the various committees from 1947 to 1978 at different periods of time. Waldorf now serves as Secretary, a position he also held last year (1977).

Waldorf has been an Officer for Hui Wa'a & Surfing Association for several years. He was Vice President in 1974 and has served as President from 1975 to the present.

I'm sure you've enjoyed all of this information about two great people, let us be sure this race today is a great honor to both of them.

You may lose the game, but you never can lose the act of being part of an activity that can stimulate you physically and mentally.


You never lose when you have put forth your maximum effort regardless of where you finish in the game.
