

Due to a temporary shortage of forms used to license ship radio stations, the Commission will use the following provisional procedures in order to provide a continuing licensing service to the shipping industry and boating community:

For New Ship Station Licenses and Renewals with Modification - Applicants for new ship radio station licenses and licensees requesting renewal, with modification, of their ship radio station licenses will be mailed a copy of this Public Notice which when combined with the mailing address label appearing on the FCC transmittal envelope, constitutes authority for them to operate their ship radio station until December 31, 1979. The radio call sign appears on the mailing address label and may be identified as being four letters or two/three letters followed by four digits. Operations shall be in accordance with Part 83 of the Commission's rules and limited to the frequencies or frequency bands for which application has been made. Regular five-year licenses will be forwarded by December 31, 1979.

For Renewals without Modification - Current rules provide that licensees who have made timely application for renewal of their ship radio station licenses without modification, may continue to operate their ship radio station in accordance with the particulars of the expired license until their renewal application is acted upon by the Commission. Applications for renewal without modification are expected to be acted upon by December 31, 1979.

For Changes Reported by Correspondence - Licensees who have reported changes by means of correspondence or FCC Form 559A will be mailed a copy of this Public Notice in confirmation that their request has been received and acted upon. A new license reflecting the requested changes will be forwarded by December 31, 1979.

For Duplicate License Requests - Licensees requesting a duplicate ship radio station license will be mailed a copy of this Public Notice which when combined with the mailing address label appearing on the FCC transmittal envelope, will constitute authority until December 31, 1979, to operate the ship radio

station on frequencies or frequency bands which appeared on the lost or mutilated license. A regular duplicate license will be mailed by December 31, 1979.

Regarding Operator Licensing - Persons operating a ship radio station must possess an FCC Restricted Radiotelephone Operator Permit or higher class operator license. This Public Notice does not convey any authority associated with a Restricted Radiotelephone Operator Permit.
