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The long term question before the board is how does P.V.S. raise an additional \$48,000 by 6/1/87? Our immediate problem is how will P.V.S. meet its expenses for the next three months. The situation is as follows:

\* \$25,000 was deducted from the \$66,000 income to repay M.B.T. loan.

P.V.S. needs additional income for October (15,640), for Nov. (33,562) and for Dec. (10,162) or 59,364 by the end of the year.

P.V.S. options are the following:

1. Stop now--raise the full amounts needed then plan to sail next year.
2. Sail to New Zealand by raising the additional \$59,000 and stopping for a year. This would require either P.V.S. raising the needed cash now and/or asking for incremental payments to cover cash deficits from Hawaii Maritime Center.
3. Continue on after Plan 2 to completion and pursue:
  - Hawaii Maritime Center pledge by asking H.M.C. to cover monthly cash deficits up to a total of \$250,000.
  - Plan fundraisers and/or membership drives to make up the \$48,000.

There are likely other options which board members can identify. Your suggestions are welcomed before we discuss the pros and cons of all the possible approaches.
